**D. National Leadership Council**

. The National Leadership Council shall be comprised of all current Affiliate Chapter Presidents and Former Chapter Presidents in good standing that have successfully completed their term of office.

. Members in good standing of the National Leadership Council shall constitute the Electoral body of NHORA and shall act as the National Advisory Council to the NHORA National Board of Directors

. The Nominations/Elections Committee of the National Leadership Council shall submit a list of nominees for NHORA National Board of Director positions from the body of the National Leadership Council PAST Presidents in good standing.

. The Nominating/Elections Committee shall call for the elections from the list of approved nominees who will be elected by majority vote of the National Leadership Council.
